This workshop aims to offer a discussion forum particularly for young researchers (PhD students and Postdocs) to present their current theoretical or empirical papers to a competent audience. Submissions in all areas of monetary and financial economics are invited, but papers on the following topics are especially welcome:

- liquidity and financial stability;
- financial innovation and financial intermediation;
- monetary policy implementation;
- implications of financial globalization;
- the role of the financial sector in DSGE models.

The presentation, which should not exceed 20 minutes, will be commented by a competent discussant.

Please submit your complete paper (max. 25 pages text) along with information about paper title, name(s) of the author(s), as well as mailing and email addresses of the corresponding author to [workshop08@iwh-halle.de](mailto:workshop08@iwh-halle.de). Pdf-files are preferred. Submission deadline is **February 1, 2008**. Authors will be notified of the Program Committee's decisions in April 2008. A conference fee will not be charged but participants are expected to cover their own travel and accommodation expenses.
