ACADEMIC WRITING II

February 27/28, 2014, 10 am – 5 pm

This workshop is intended to build on the Academic Writing seminar held in October 2012 at the IWH; however, it by no means excludes newcomers. As opposed to merely focusing on the abstract, in this workshop we will explore the nature of a research paper in its entirety, paying particular attention to sentence, argument and paragraph structure as well as other finer points of mechanics. On the second day, participants will have the opportunity to present current research results in the context of a conference presentation, thereby translating the written material into oral form.

All participants are strongly encouraged to bring along any research papers which have either already been published or still in the writing stage. There will be ample opportunity to undertake in-class written assignments, which will subsequently be evaluated and reviewed both by the instructor and peers.

Aims

- Develop basic academic writing skills
- Gain exposure to useful presentation techniques

- Structure of research paper
- Mechanics of writing
- Paragraphing and sentence structure
- Formulating a sound literature review
- Presenting research results at a conference

Methods

- Pair- and group work
- Individual writing assignments
- Group discussion
- Individual presentations
