The research project is headed by Dr Franziska Bremus (DIW Berlin) and Assistant Professor Dr Lena Tonzer (IWH Halle & VU Amsterdam). The contract will be limited to three years; an extension by one year is possible. The place of employment is Halle (Saale), whereas research stays at the cooperating institutions are possible.
