## 26<sup>th</sup> IWH-CIREQ-GW-BOKERI Macroeconometric Workshop: Artificial Intelligence and Macroeconometrics on December 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 in Halle (Saale), Germany

The workshop offers a forum for the discussion of recent advances in empirical and applied macroeconomic modelling, with a particular focus on fostering collaboration between academic researchers and policy professionals. We invite submissions of both applied and theoretical papers covering a broad range of topics in time series analysis and macroeconometrics. Submissions addressing artificial intelligence and macroeconometrics are especially welcome. Each day of the conference will feature a keynote speaker addressing the key topic, alongside contributed paper sessions, discussions, and poster presentations.
